


## Q1: Are you currently a member of a student organization at ETSU?

# Q4: What resources are you taking advantage of during this time while classes are taking place online only?





Most of our membership are in medical school and are continuing their studies or moving into periods of licensure testing, so we are trying to be respectful of the increased work load they have on them as well.

Traditionally, we have participated in college-based recognition ceremonies, and with the current situation, we are looking for ways at the broader school level to recognize and celebrate our graduating members.
