Eligibility: For individuals, not employed as an academic advisor or academic counselor, who support and enhance the profession of academic advising, leading to improved advising practices, services to students, and student success.

Criteria: This award recognizes an advocate to the advising community who:

- Demonstrates a caring and helpful attitude toward advisors, faculty, staff, and students
- Develops relationships with other individuals and offices on campus that help attend to the needs of academic advisors and students
- Displays strong understanding of institutions policies, procedures, and regulations
- Seeks opportunities to be engaged with the academic advising community and stays up-to-date with changes in campus personnel and institutional policy
