Admission to ETSU Teacher Education Requirements:

- Formal application to College of Education Teacher Education Program.
- Completion of 32 semester hours of General Education courses including 6 hrs. English 1010 & 1020, 8 hrs. Sciences, and 3 hrs. Mathematics.
- Pass CSCI 1100 or UIT Proficiency Exam.
- GPA of a least 2.50 on all General Education work as reflected in calculated GPA excluding Developmental Studies classes.
- ACT composite score of a least 22; or SAT combined scores of at least 1020 R (old V) & M only; or Praxis scores of 174 in Reading, 173 in Math, and 173 in Writing.
- Submission of portfolio as initiated in EDFN 2300.
- Completion of successful interview with the College of Education Admission Board.
- Demonstration of good moral character and freedom from any condition that would impair effectiveness as a teacher. Includes passing scores on an approved speech and hearing test and notarized statement of character.
- Completion of EDFN 2100, EDFN 2300 and ECED 2150 with a grade of "C" or better.

- In addition, students must complete a background check and receive clearance. (This MUST be initiated through ETSU's Clemmer College of Education Advisement Office, 321 Warf-Pickel.)

USING INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY proficiency required, either by passing a proficiency exam or CSCI 1100 completion. See the website <http://www.etsu.edu/uit> for proficiency exam or call (423) 439-6964 for additional information to register.

Transfer students with 50 or more transferable hours are required to take half the intensives requirements two writing, one oral, and one using information technology). You must take these courses at ETSU as transfer credit does not satisfy the intensive requirements. In this articulation agreement, these courses are indicated by: Writing (W), Oral (O), and Using Information Technology (T). NOTE: Intensive courses are built into ETSU program requirements. They are not additional hours.
