Transfer students with 50 or more transferable hours are required to take half the intensive requirements of native students. Therefore, you will need two writing, one oral communication, and one using information technology intensive courses. You must take these courses at ETSU; transfer credit does not satisfy the intensive requirements. Your advisor at ETSU will help you select these courses. **NOTE: Intensive courses are built into ETSU program requirements. They are not additional hours.**
