

Holly Adams Scholarship

Description:

The Holly Adams Scholarship is awarded to a second semester sophomore art student, and the money is applied for tuition payment during the junior year of study. The actual monetary award varies from year to year.

Criteria:

1. Only *declared art majors* may apply.
2. **Only Second Semester Sophomores may apply.**
3. Only those students who have been enrolled full-time during this academic year may apply.
4. By the end of this semester, applicants must complete 12 art courses (both studio and art history classes). Example: applicants might have completed 1110, 1140, 1201, 1204, 2010, 2020, and 6 courses at the 2XXX level.
5. If awarded the scholarship, you must be enrolled full-time and in 3 art classes during each semester of the junior year.

How to apply:

Submit the following:

1. A portfolio of 8 to 10 works completed while a student at ETSU. Use a portfolio. 3-D students may place work in boxes. Originals, slides or c.d. images will be accepted. Clearly label the portfolio with your name, address, telephone numbers and "Holly Adams Scholarship" clearly printed on the upper left corner of the portfolio. On the back, bottom, or side of each work, securely attach your name, address, and phone.
2. A copy of your school records with all semester grades and current classes.
3. A one-page statement regarding your long term artistic goals. This should be no longer than 150-200 words.

Deadline:

1. Applications must be submitted by **March 13, 2009**. (Call Art Office at 439-4247).
2. Submit to the Art Office.

Entries must be picked up from the Art Office after April 3, 2009. Any non-compliance with the above requirements may result in immediate disqualification.
