

JURY PROCESS

The Positive/Negative 25 Annual Juried Art Exhibition accepts ONLY digital images in a CD-ROM. Artists should submit electronic images in JPG (at least 300 dpi) format. Entries submitted without electronic images will be disqualified. No slide entries will be accepted. All images should be clearly labeled with the following information:

Artist.Entry#.Title.Year.Media.jpg

Label the CD with the Artist's full name and "Positive/Negative25" and send inside a clear hard case for handling. Electronic images should be accompanied by a one-page printout that includes all entry images showing top-front orientation of work.

Accepted work will be disqualified if misrepresented or photos are digitally enhanced. Only one electronic image per 2D entry; 3D work may include a detail shot.

All video art submissions should be in digital form and submitted in either CD-ROM or DVD; video art should not exceed 30 minutes running time. All accepted video art will be played via flat screen monitor on a loop during exhibition; unless accompanied by a viewing device from artist.

Include an Image List with Artist Statement in Word document containing (1) Artist's information (name, address, email, contact nos.) and (2) Entry Information (i.e., name, entry no., title of work, year, medium, size, etc.) and (3) brief artistic statement in 150 words or less. All submitted application materials will become property of the Slocumb Galleries. CDs will not be returned. Artists agree that Slocumb Galleries may use images for educational and promotional purposes. Work should be original and the sole copyright property of the Artist. Slocumb Galleries will be indemnified for any legal claims on the submitted work.

ELIGIBILITY

The Annual Positive/Negative 25 National Juried Art Exhibition is open to all artists 18 years and older residing in the United States. All work must be original and completed within the last two years. Work previously submitted to the Positive/Negative or exhibited at the Slocumb Galleries may not be resubmitted. Current students and employees of East Tennessee State University are not eligible to apply.

JURY NOTIFICATION

Notification of accepted entries will be sent via email and postal service (using SASE) starting January 1, 2010. The Juror's decision is final. Late, incomplete, or non-compliant entries will not be considered. Inquiries regarding submissions and delivery of work should be addressed to Slocumb Galleries Director, Karlota I. INSURANCE AND SALES

Accepted entries will be insured ONLY during the installation and exhibition of work at the Slocumb Galleries. The Artist is responsible for all insurance and shipping costs during transit. Please ensure that work is securely packed and labeled for both shipping and hand-delivered submissions. The Slocumb Galleries will not be responsible for loss, theft, or damages to work with inadequate packaging and shipping provisions. A 30 percent commission will be retained on all work sold during the exhibition. Insurance value does not include the gallery commission. Please include both the gallery and insurance prices on the Entry Form. A signed Insurance/Loan Agreement Form will be required for all accepted entries. Works not for sale must still include insurance value and clearly marked NFS.

SHIPPING AND DELIVERY

Accepted entries may be shipped or hand-delivered. All shipped and hand-delivered work must be adequately packed in secure reusable containers. Do not send work framed with glass. Installation instructions and hardware should be included.

Shipped work should include a pre-paid label for return shipping. Work without return provisions and that which is not claimed after 60 days after the last day of exhibition will become property of the Slocumb Galleries.
