

Faculty Tenure and Promotion, 2008

Nine ETSU College of Arts and Sciences faculty members were promoted and six were granted tenure by the university's governing body, the Tennessee Board of Regents, through action taken during its quarterly meeting in Nashville.

A total of 122 faculty members at the six universities within the TBR system achieved tenure, and 176 university faculty received promotions. The sixth largest system of higher education in the nation, the TBR provides programs to more than 180,000 students in 90 of Tennessee's 95 counties.

The following ETSU faculty members attained the rank of *full professor*: **David Champouillon**, Music; **Martha Copp**, Sociology and Anthropology; **Anita DeAngelis**, Art and Design; and **Elwood Watson**, History.

Elevated to *associate professor* were the following: **Kelly Dorgan**, Communication; **Mira Gerard** and **Patricia Mink**, Art and Design; **Joe Keith Green**, Philosophy and Humanities; **Andrew Slap**, History.

The following faculty members were granted *tenure* in addition to their promotions: **Dorgan, Gerard, Green, Mink, and Slap**.

Another faculty member also achieved *tenure*: **Paul Baggett**, Social Work.
