ETSU Summer Piano Camp, July 7-11, 2008, is a day camp designed for students in Grades 6-12 who have studied piano for at least two years.

The week's classes will include:

- ♪ Three 30-minute private piano lessons
- ♪ Introduction to the organ
- ♪ Master classes in piano and organ
- ♪ Ear training and sight-singing
- ♪ Piano ensemble
- ♪ Percussion ensemble
- ♪ Chorus
- ♪ Supervised practice sessions



The camp schedule begins at 8:00 a.m. and finishes at 5:00 p.m. Performances include two student recitals and a faculty recital. Recitals are scheduled Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 5:15 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. All classes and recitals take place in Mathes Hall on the campus of ETSU, except Wednesday, when students will spend "Organ Day" at Munsey Memorial United Methodist Church in Johnson City.



Each day during lunch break, students embark on a one-hour, on-campus field trip, exploring different non-musical areas of interest. In past summers, campers have visited the ETSU Planetarium, Sherrod Library, Reece Museum, WETS Public Radio Station, ETSU Arboretum, Department of Theatre, and the Center for Physical Activity.

Students should bring three pieces for study: one thoroughly polished and memorized, one that is new or "rough," and a polished Baroque or Classical piece for the organ master class (memory not required – short excerpt acceptable).

This summer, students will be treated to a special "kickoff" recital on Sunday, July 6 at 3:00 p.m., at Munsey Memorial United Methodist Church in Johnson City. This recital will feature piano camp's special guest clinician and organist, Dr. David Runner.

Dr. Runner will perform on Munsey's R. A. Colby, three manual, forty-seven rank pipe organ. Dr. Runner will be conducting master classes on this magnificent organ on Wednesday of camp week.



Application deadline is May 15, 2008. Total camp fee is \$230. Please enclose a check with the application form for the full amount, payable to ETSU Department of Music, by May 15, 2008.

You may cancel your application and receive a refund, less \$50.00 (non-refundable portion of camp fee) if the request is made by June 16, three weeks prior to the start of camp. **No money will be refunded for any reason after June 16, 2008.** Students arriving late for camp or leaving early are not eligible for any monetary compensation.
