- Teachers will not be considered candidates for add-on endorsements until a record is begun with the certification officer, beginning with the *Declaration of Intent to Pursue Additional Teaching Endorsement*. The forms may be printed from the COE website: <http://coe.etsu.edu/students/forms/index.htm> or picked up at the Office of Education Student Services: Room 321, Warf-Pickel Bldg.
- All substitution requests and approvals must be routed through the certification officer in the College of Education. See reverse side for more about exceptions and substitutions.
- Teacher education students who are pursuing initial teaching license and wish to add credits toward an add-on endorsement may do so. Please be advised, however, add-on programs do not necessarily meet the requirements of a minor and substitutions or approvals made for teaching add-ons do not take the place of catalog requirements or departmental advisement for degree purposes.
- Courses counted toward an add-on must have a minimum grade of "C-" or equivalent unless otherwise stated in this program sheet.
- Add-ons will not be verified unless all requirements for initial Tennessee teaching license are met.
- When the teacher has met the process specifications above, and qualifying Praxis II exams, he/she will be eligible to add the new teaching endorsement to the existing Tennessee license. To obtain the necessary verification of completed process:
- Have qualifying Praxis II score reports submitted to ETSU College of Education, Recipient code #1198. The score reports must come directly from the Educational Testing Service to the College of Education. Copies of the examinee's score report will not be accepted.
- The candidate must submit to the Certification Officer in the College of Education the appropriate application for amendment to licensure with official transcripts of all college credit.
- Praxis II information and Application for Amendment to Licensure are available in Room 321 Warf-Pickel Bldg.
