General Criteria:

- Out-of-state students
- Must be a new graduate student during the first semester that the scholarship is awarded.
- Admission to a graduate certificate or degree program
- Full-time and part-time students
- Students who have been awarded a graduate tuition scholarship or a graduate assistantship are not eligible for these scholarships
- Students whose out-of-state tuition has been waived through the Border-County Waiver, the Academic Common Market, the fee waiver for out-of-state part-time students working full-time in Tennessee, or any other scholarship or waiver for out-of-state tuition are NOT eligible for these scholarships.
- Out-of-state tuition up to maximum of \$4000 per semester for fall and spring terms. Students will pay all of the in-state maintenance fees, any remaining out-of-state tuition, and all other student and course fees.

Out-of-State Graduate Scholarship

Applicants must be U.S. citizens and must be applying to a graduate program with growth capacity to be eligible. RODP Programs are not eligible.

Diversity Graduate Student Out-of-State Scholarship – Applicants must be U.S. citizens. Any ETSU graduate program. RODP programs are not eligible.
