Professional Nurse Traineeships (Federal) (Not available for 2006-2007)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Available to full time graduate Nursing students
- Preference is given to students who intend to work in a health professional shortage area upon graduation

Application Process:

- Students will be informed by College of Nursing of application process and deadline of appropriate time.

Award Amounts and Comments:

- Individual awards are variable depending upon annual federal funding.
 - Funds issued at the end of Fall and Spring terms.

- Undergraduate, Graduate, and Post-Graduate Nursing scholarship and loan information resources.
- Eligibility requirements vary.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Non-conditional admission/enrollment in an accredited Graduate Program in specific states (TN).
- Personal commitment to prepare for a position as a nurse educator in an academic setting.
- GPA 3.25 or better
- Enrolled in 6 credits PT or 15 credits FT over an academic year.

Eligibility Requirements:

Graduate Assistantships (University)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be admitted to graduate program.
- Must be enrolled in at least 9 graduate nursing hours per semester (Fall and Spring) and at least 6 graduate hours in the Summer term.
- Students must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Full and half-time graduate assistants require a work commitment of 20 and 10 hours per week, respectively.

Application Process:

- Awarded by the College of Nursing.

Award Amounts and Comments:

- An annual appointment provided for a waiver of out-of-state fee (Fall, Spring, Summer); waiver of graduate maintenance fee (Fall, Spring); and a monthly stipend.
 - Half-time appointments are available with modified provisions.

Tuition Scholarships (University)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Merit (academic) based award given to students admitted to an ETSU graduate degree program for the first time.
- Students must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Requires a work commitment of 8 hours per week.

Application Process:

Award Amounts and Comments:

- An annual appointment provided for a waiver of out-of-state fee (Fall, Spring, Summer); waiver of graduate maintenance fee (Fall, Spring).

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must be residents of the First Congressional District of Tennessee (Carter, Claiborne, Cocke, Grainger, Greene, Hamblen, Hancock, Hawkins, Jefferson, Knox, Sevier, Sullivan, Unicoi, and Washington counties).
- Applicants must have documented financial need as determined through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Graduate applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Eligibility Requirements:

Joanna B. Slemmons Memorial Scholarship Endowment (College of Nursing)

Eligibility Requirements:

-- Applicant must be in pre-nursing, nursing, Master's, or Doctoral nursing program.

-- Applicant must have and maintain at least a 3.3 GPA.

-- Recipients are chosen by the College of Nursing Student Affairs Committee and approved by the Dean.

Sharon Whitaker Memorial Emergency Short-Term Loan (College of Nursing)

Eligibility Requirements:

-- Applicants must be enrolled at least half-time in the nursing major (BSN, MSN, or DSN), with tuition paid or deferred.

- Applicants must be receiving specific and adequate resources to make repayment (i.e., anticipated financial aid).
- Applicant must not be on university Accounts Receivable for prior debts to ETSU.

Application Process:

Award Amounts and Comments:

- Funds are to aid students with emergency needs or unexpected expenses related to educational costs. Loans may be made up to \$250 per student, per semester, and may not be made for tuition and/or fee payment.
- Maximum of one (1) short-term loan per academic year, cosigner required; loans are made for up to 90 days, or until the end of the semester, whichever occurs first.
