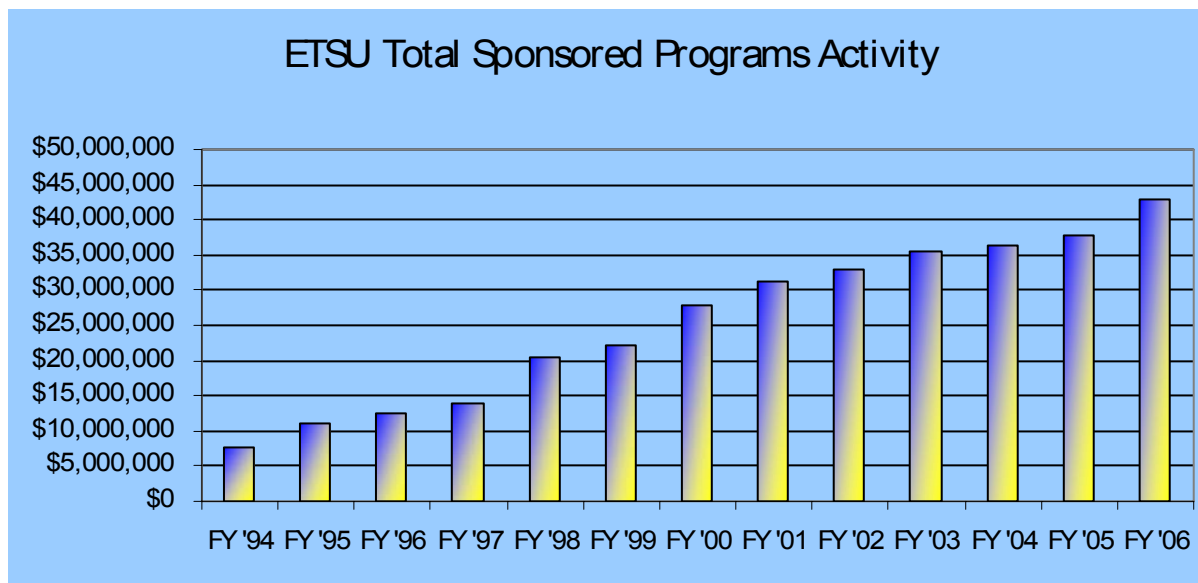

Message from the Vice Provost for Research

For FY 2006 total sponsored programs activity at ETSU increased by 12% compared to the FY 2005 total. Following a decrease from FY 1993 to FY 1994, total sponsored program dollars have increased at ETSU for 12 consecutive years. Over the past ten years, total external funding for grants and contracts has increased by more than 300%.



This increase occurred in an increasingly competitive environment and is the result of institutional commitment and, to lapse into the colloquial, of a whole lot of hard work on the part of ETSU faculty and staff. Collectively ETSU faculty and staff recognized that to do all of the things that they wanted to do, they had to aggressively pursue resources other than those provided through the state appropriation and student tuition and fees. The dollars generated through grants and contracts have enabled ETSU to advance its three-part mission of teaching, research and service in ways that would not have been at all possible without this external support.

Please accept my congratulations on not just the success in generating such a significant amount of money, but on the work you have been able to do as a result of this funding. The dollars are in many ways just an easy way to show the quality of the work you do and the significant creativity that underlies your ability to attract these resources.

Things to note about formatting:

- Grant proposals submitted in one fiscal year are not always awarded in the same fiscal year. Therefore direct comparisons should not be made between the number of proposals submitted and the number of awards received in a given fiscal year, nor the amount requested and the amount received.
- Only new awards received during FY 06 are counted in “number of awards” or “number of grants/contracts awarded”. Continuing awards (awards initially received in a previous fiscal year) are not counted in “number of awards” but their dollar amounts are included in “amount awarded”.
- Grant proposals and grant awards with multiple co-investigators are accounted for in the department and division of the principal investigator. Co-investigators from different departments and divisions are acknowledged in the section “Awards received by individuals during FY 06” at the end of this report.
- In FY 03 we revised the definition of the “Industry” sponsor category to include sponsors from the healthcare industry. Healthcare industry sponsors were previously accounted for in the “Other” category. As a result of this change, there is an increase in the “Industry” category and a concomitant decrease in the “Other” category beginning in FY 03.
- In previous reports we used “Private” sponsor category to include foundation and association sponsors. We have changed the name of this category to “foundations and associations” or “F&A” to add clarity to our terminology.

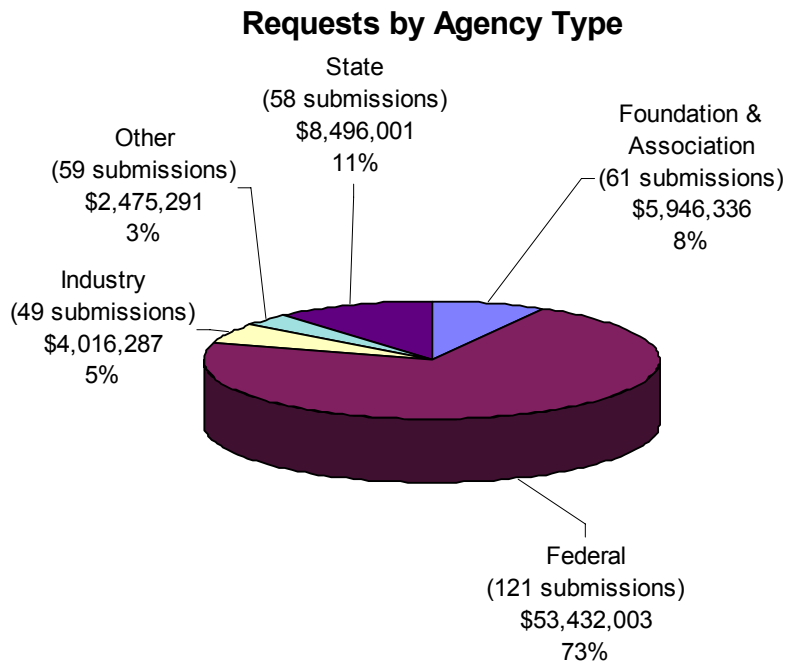
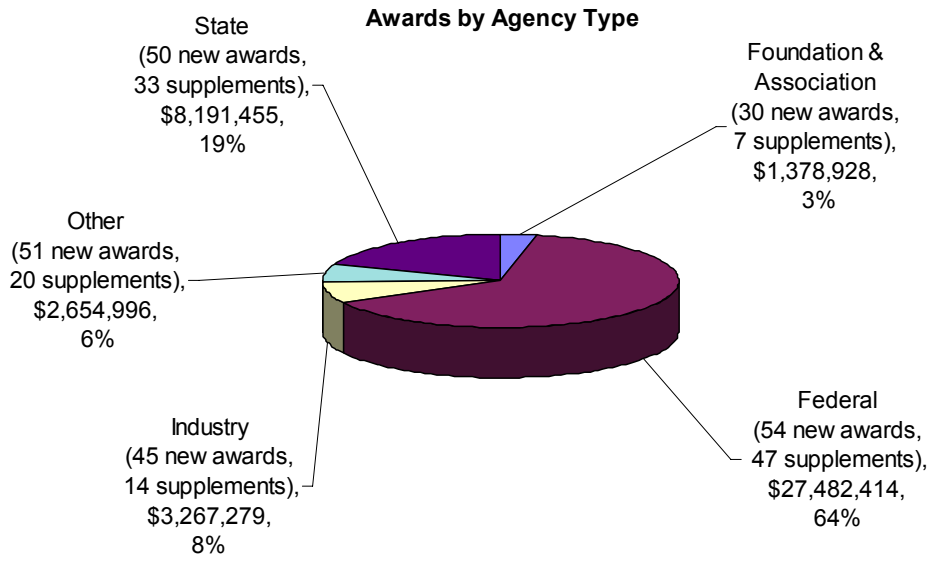

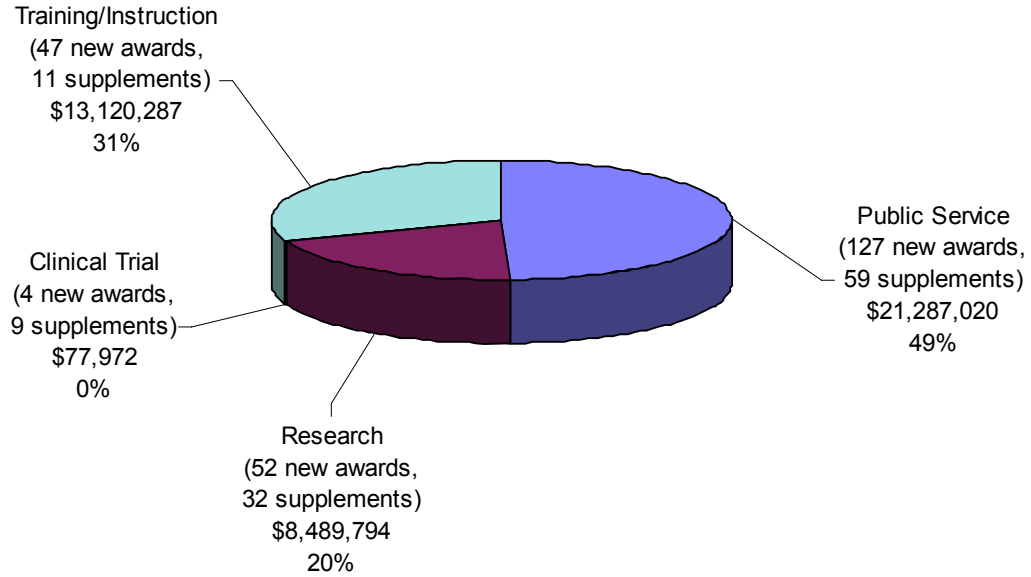

Requests by Project Type

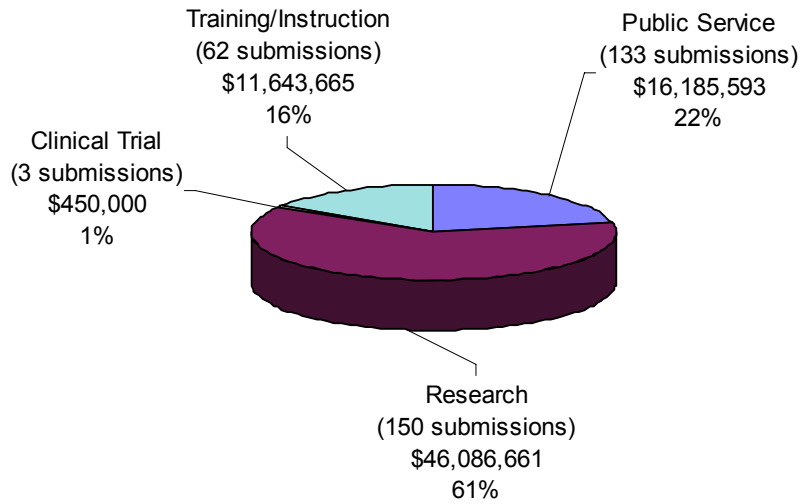
