

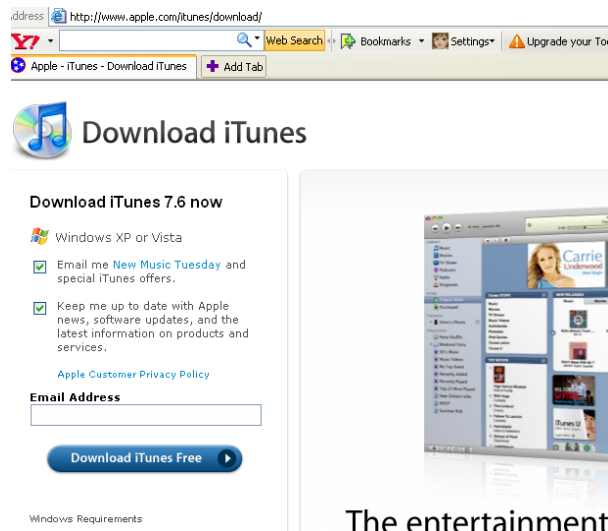
Podcasting Handout

What is Podcasting?

Podcasting is an innovative way for faculty to deliver course content. ETSU faculty/staff are using podcasts to record lectures, provide supplemental notes to in-class lectures, record poetry, and increase student awareness of campus events. Your instructors will provide you with information about how podcasts will be used in your courses.

How do I get started?

1. You will need to download iTunes. <http://www.apple.com/itunes/download/>



You can download the iTunes software for free. You will need to enter your e-mail address and then choose "Download iTunes Free." You will then Select "Save" from the pop-up menu that appears on the screen.

2. Once you have installed the iTunes software, access the ETSU iTunes U podcasting page: <http://www.etsu.edu/itunesu/index.jsp> You'll need to choose "Open ETSU Podcasts-password protected" from the menu on this page. You will then be re-directed to a page where you will be asked to enter your goldmail username and password. The ETSU iTunes page will then open in iTunes:



3. From here you will use the scroll bar at the right of the window to scroll to "Academic Podcasts". You will then click on the name of the college in which the course you are taking is offered. Then click on the title of your instructor's podcast. You will then select the episode of the podcast you would like to hear by clicking on the word "Get" at the right of the page:



- Once you have downloaded the podcast, an ETSU playlist folder will be created in iTunes and it will be organized by podcast title. From this playlist you can choose to burn CDs or transfer files to your iPod.
