Attention Bridge Students: How to Sign up for the May 9th Orientation

When you log into your gold link, you should see an invitation to an orientation (see below). Go ahead and complete the Launch link. Then, you will need to complete the Quiz. When it prompts you to select an orientation date, select May 9th.

When it prompts you to pay for orientation, click out of the browser. UB is paying for your orientation!

If it does not give you May 9th for an orientation date, you may not have a start date of Summer 2019. You will need to change your start date to Summer 2019 and then repeat these steps.
