Update from Karen Hirst:

The next steps are to share the recommendation reports with the executive leadership. At some point it I imagine it will be shared with the community. - Non-registered report is coming out weekly. This report is shared with advisors.
- First Year Experience (FYE) courses Please encourage your new students to take a first-year experience (FYE) course this fall
- ETSU Tuition and Fees summer fees have been posted. There are no summer payment plans.
- Fall fees will NOT be posted until mid-July.
- Account balance change If a student owes less than \$2,000 for spring term they
  can still register for fall term. Some exceptions apply due to prior term balances,
  etc.

- California Critical Thinking Skills Test (CCTST) has been waived for students graduating May 2020. The CCTST status for summer graduating students has not been decided.
- Late drop and withdrawal deadline for spring term is today, April 28<sup>th</sup>.
- Carrier Center's (previously known as ARC) earliest move-in might be 2020 winter break. Renovations have begun.

# Carshonda Martin, Multicultural Center – Bridge Program update

- The Summer Bridge Program has been postponed to August 2020.

## Megan Flora, <u>University Health Center</u> - Immunization Update

- The Hep. B forms for students that are under 18 the parent must create a login account with their name.
- Immunization records can be faxed, or emailed.
- Since all summer classes are online students can complete online only waiver.
- Waivers for one semester are available.

## Stacy Onks, University Advisement Center - ACCUPLACER Update

- Accuplacer The Accuplacer is back up and running with remote proctoring. UAC is reaching out to inform the students as they have in the past. If a student contacts you about testing, please have them call UAC. Nothing else has changed; Accuplacer is still untimed and the cost is \$30. ETSU is absorbing the remote proctor fee for students while we are off campus. Scores are immediate upon completion. UAC is not scheduling any challenge exams at this time due to proctor availability. If you have extenuating circumstances, please call Stacy Onks (96942) to discuss the individual student situation.
- LS students on the Orientation list To identify the students requiring LS on the
  Orientation list, a column has been added. In the Learning Support column, a "Y"
  (for yes) indicates that Learning Support is required and the UAC will handle their
  advisement until LS requirements in Reading and Writing are completed. UAC is
  issuing Math permits for students as the Orientation list is released. If UAC can
  do anything to make this process easier, please reach out always open to
  changing things up to make it work better for you and the student!
