- *Choose From Dual License/ESL Pathway or Elementary Pathway
-If the student chooses the Dual License Elementary/ESL Pathway, two world languages will be taken, and the student will not need to take EDFN 2310. Language options include: Spanish, German, Japanese, French, ASL, or any language with World Language Classification.
- *Entrance into EdPrep requires ACT 21 or higher, SAT 1080 combined score or higher, Praxis Core: Reading-156, Math 150, Writing-162, by Summer entering Senior Year
- All major classes must be a C or higher, with the exception of ED201/EDFN2400 requires a B- or higher.
