## General information for applying to the Biology Masters program at East Tennessee State University

- We offer two admissions periods, one in the Fall (the deadline to apply is Febraury 1<sup>st</sup>) and the other in the Spring (the deadline to apply is August 1<sup>st</sup>). Late applications may be considered but not given priority. - Application materials include 1) an Official transcript, 2) two recommendation letters, and 3) a personal statement. At this time <u>GRE is no</u> <u>longer required.</u>
- Graduate assistantships (GAs) and Tuition scholarships (TS) are generally available but these are competitive and cannot be guaranteed. Students will be notified if they are selected for a GA/ TS. <u>No neeed for a separate application.</u>
- Selected applicants should be prepared to have a virtual interview with the graduate committee.
- Ideal applicants will have a major in the life or physical sciences, with supporting courses in general chemistry and physics with a minimum 3.0 overall grade point average (on a 4.0 system) in their major <a href="https://www.etsu.edu/gradschool/masters-degrees.php">https://www.etsu.edu/gradschool/masters-degrees.php</a>.
