

English Honors-in-Discipline Course Checklist

The English Honors Program requires you to complete all of the following courses:

___ Honors Composition (ENGL 1028 or 3130-088)*—*offered ever semester; students also participating in the University Honors Scholars Program may meet this requirement by completing ENGL/PHIL 1228*

___ Honors Literature Survey (ENGL 2138, 2238, 2338, or 2438)—*one of the four is offered every semester on rotating basis*

___ Honors Focus (ENGL 3118)—*offered every fall semester*

___ Honors Special Topics (ENGL 3128)—*offered every spring semester*

___ Honors Shakespeare (ENGL 4008)—*offered every fall semester*

___ Honors Thesis (ENGL 4018)

*Students who enter English HID after taking English 1020 must take an honors enriched section of 3130; this does not apply, however, to those student also participating in the University Honors Scholars Program
