*Admitted students receive University support through a graduate assistantship for at least the first two years. The support includes a stipend of \$13,000, a waiver of in-state or out-of-state tuition for fall and spring terms, and a waiver of Arts & Sciences fees of \$50/credit hour. For the 2026-2027 training year, 12 graduate credits would otherwise be \$6,854 (in state tuition) or \$14,414 (out-of-state tuition). The University requires continuous enrollment associated with Thesis and Dissertation requirements, with one credit hour of summer enrollment totaling \$692 for approximately three summer terms. Sources of graduate assistantship support in the remaining two years pre-internship vary, and include community training grants and contracts, teaching assistantships, or faculty grants. To date, 100% of enrolled students have been offered at least 4 years of graduate assistantship support and associated tuition waivers. Travel awards are available from departmental and university funds.
