Educator Disposition Assessment: Studies have revealed educator dispositions -- traits and beliefs that guide thoughts, actions, and character – are just as, if not more, important as knowledge and skill within classroom settings. For this reason, a key assessment in the School Librarianship Program is the Educator Disposition Assessment developed by Educational Dispositional Consultants, LLC. The assessment can be self or instructor driven.

- Fall, 2022 - Spring 2023 – average score (maximum a 4) – 3.91

Lesson Plan: developed and validated for reliability on a continuous basis by Clemmer College faculty members. Scoring results for the lesson plan during the 2022-2023 academic year were:

MEDA 5628 (beginning point)

- Spring 2023: mean score on lesson plan was 85

MEDA 5926 (midpoint)

- Fall 2022: mean score on lesson plan was 90.47
- Spring 2023: mean score on lesson plan was 88

MEDA 5929 (final point)

- Fall 2022: mean score on lesson plan was 94

Spring 2023: mean score on lesson plan was 95
