Cohorts participate in a focus group at the end of the licensure coursework. Feedback is considered in future course and internship assignments. Specific feedback from the 2024 completers regarded the value of the School Improvement Plan across all six semesters. They began to see the value of it during the fourth semester and indicated they were making a strong contribution during the fifth and sixth semesters.

Alumni provide feedback on program preparation and updates on attainment of jobs in school leadership. Forty-four alumni responded to a recent survey specific to internship, the relationship of internship to leadership standards, and the degree to which the internship prepared them for leadership roles. The responses to the survey were all significantly positive in all areas.

The internship supervisor conducts interviews with LEAs on their satisfaction of graduate preparation. ETSU remains the school of choice for district directors.
