Teacher Candidate Graduation Regalia Information & Survey

The Office of Educator Preparation will be distributing teacher candidate graduation regalia before the Spring 2021 Commencement Ceremonies. To best support our candidates we will be offering both pick-up and mailing options for teacher candidate regalia. Pickup of this regalia will take place in the Office of Educator Preparation (Warf-Pickel 305) on May 4 -7, 2021. If you would like to have your teacher candidate regalia mailed to you, mailout will begin May 3rd.

Teacher Candidate Regalia:

- Teacher Licensure Pin: Students will receive a pin if they have completed all Residency II requirements, passed edTPA, and have passed all required Praxis examinations
- edTPA Scholar Honor Cord: Students will receive this honor cord if they obtained a score of 45 or higher on there edTPA assessment.
- edTPA Scholar Medallion: Students will receive a honor medallion if they obtained a score of 55 or higher on there edTPA assessment.

Residency Makeup Day Information

If you have missed any days during residency this semester, below is important information concerning what is designated as missed days and how you can make up these days before the end of the semester.

What are counted as missed residency days?

- All absences during school days (Virtual and In-person) must be made up (this includes Covid-19 related absences).
- Excused days: edTPA Writing Day, edTPA Bootcamp, edTPA Upload Day, Substitute Training, Career Fair

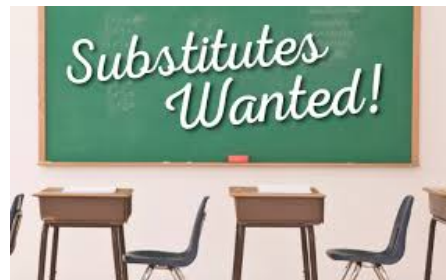
When can I make-up my missed residency days?

- Residency Makeup days should be completed May 3-7
- In the event that you are going to miss more than 5 days, missed days will need to be made up during the week of May 10-14.

Substituting During Residency

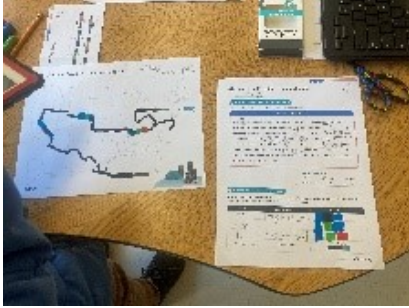


General Substitute Information

- **Candidates can NOT be used as a substitute without completing requirements. This is due to liability issues.**
 - Candidates must complete the district substitute training and turn in the Candidate to Substitute Agreement form before being allowed to substitute.
 - If you have already submitted the Candidate to Substitute Agreement during your first placement, your second placement mentor will need to email your substituting permission to your ETSU supervisor.
 - Substitute hours, class and grade level should be logged in LiveText on a daily/weekly basis.
 - Candidate to Substitute Agreement will be added to LiveText once they are received by the Office of Educator Preparation (uploaded as an attachment).
