REGULARLY SCHEDULED SERIES (RSS)	\$ 0
<p>Definition: The Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) defines a regularly scheduled series in the following way: <i>A course is identified as a regularly scheduled series (RSS) when it is planned to have 1. A series with multiple sessions that; 2. Occur on an ongoing basis (offered weekly, monthly, or quarterly) and; 3. Are primarily planned by and presented to the accredited organization's professional staff. Examples of activities that are planned and presented as a RSS are Grand Rounds, Tumor Boards, and M&M conferences.</i></p> <p>A RSS recurs at the same time and location each week/month/quarter. Any sessions held outside of the regular time and location stated on the CME application are not considered a part of the RSS activity.</p>
