The JRCERT has defined not actively seeking employment as: 1) graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts; 2) graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation; 3) graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours; 4) graduate is on active military duty; or 5) graduate is continuing education.
