Provide a copy of a court’s decision documenting you are in legal guardianship from the state of your legal residence.
<input type="checkbox"/> Orphan, Foster Child, or Ward of the Court Any time after the age of 13 both parents passed away, you were in foster care, or a ward of the court (the courts assumed legal custody of you).	Provide death certificates for both parents or copy of a court’s decision documenting placement into foster care or the court’s assuming legal custody over you.

This form submitted without documentation will be denied. If you have marked “yes” to any of the above questions on your FAFSA in error, you must correct your FAFSA and include parental information. Notify the ETSU’s Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships 3-5 business days after you have corrected your FAFSA to include parental information. The corrected FAFSA will not automatically clear this requirement.
