

Out-of-school-time programs give parents peace of mind, allow them to work a full schedule, and help them be more productive on the job and successful in their careers, including our essential workers. They also offer social and emotional support and enriching activities that spark kids' interest in school and learning.

Research shows that students participating in high-quality afterschool programs are less likely to abuse drugs or alcohol; are more likely to advance to the next grade and graduate from high school; earn higher grades and do better on standardized tests. Some out-of-school-time programs even provide opportunities for youth to gain employability skills, connect with local businesses, and explore possible careers.


