

ETSU Retirees Association Board Meeting

Tuesday, September 27, 2016

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 3:34 pm by President Mike Miyamoto. Finance Committee: Mr. Charles Moore, Chair: Charles presented the following report: Operating Account \$6,571.85; Life Membership Account \$20,165.52; Scholarship Endowment Investment Account \$195,541.80; Endowment Interest Income Account \$20,410.18 and ETSURA Special Projects Fund \$271.08 for a total of \$242,960.43.
