OBJECTIVES

- To determine what research methodologies East Tennessee State University (ETSU) researchers utilize.
- To evaluate how ETSU's research production and quality of research compares to it's peer universities: Florida Atlantic University (FAU) and University of South Alabama (USA).

METHODS


- An affiliation search was conducted for each of the institutions in PubMed for the 3 years occurring between August 1, 2013 and July 31, 2016.
- Three reviewers looked at the PubMed results to determine article type.
- Two other reviewers then sorted article types into relevant categories according to an evidence pyramid.

RESULTS

LIMITATION

• PubMed was the only database searched. Incorporating other databases may give a more thorough view of the research output of the universities.
