### Recommended Materials:

- Blood Pressure Cuff: Manual, Adult cuff (size 11), Aneroid dial manometer (not digital) (*any brand or model that meets these specifications is fine*).

Example cuffs have the manometer separate from the bulb which is how most available COP/COM blood pressure cuffs are designed. Be sure that you have a size 11 cuff (average adult) then you are welcome to obtain additional cuff sizes and/or colors as desired. You may want a carrying case.
