


Course Substitution in the Responsive Dashboard



Exceptions in Degree Works

Exceptions allow for a diversion from the standard curriculum requirement and the substitution of other coursework.

With the new responsive dashboard Exceptions have their own tab at the top of the page. Exceptions are entered slightly differently than before, they are no longer located at the top of the page. These are now located by each rule using the '+' icon. The plus sign is used to enter all exceptions.

Degree Works allows you to process the following types of exceptions:

Force Complete This exception completes a course rule, subset rule, block qualifier or rule qualifier without applying additional classes. It is the most powerful exception type available

Substitute This exception allows you to substitute one course for another

Also Allow This exception appends a course to a course list on a rule


Apply Here This exception allows the user to apply a specific course to a rule regardless of the Scribe text or the auditor best-fit algorithm. The auditor will not move courses applied to rules with this exception type unless a block or rule qualifier overrides the exception.

Remove Course/ Change the Limit

This exception allows you to remove a class from a course rule or qualifier or to change the number of classes or credits required on a rule or qualifier.

Some exception types require more information than others. The bottom half of the screen shows an audit report for the student. The audit shows where each course has been applied and what remaining requirements are left outstanding. The radio buttons are used for selecting the rule on which to add the selected exception.

To add a new exception, select the exception type from the Exception Type drop-down list.

In the description field, the department or title of the person approving the exception should be listed. The detail field does not show on the audit so you can leave blank.

The applied exceptions will show up on the audit. Keep in mind that you are still in the **EXCEPTIONS** view. To return to the academic audit click on the **'WORKSHEETS'** tab

Standard format for Description:

per (Title of Position) or (Title of College/Department)

- e.g. 1. per Associate Dean of Arts and Sciences
- 2. per Accounting Chair
- 3. per College of Education

When to use each function

For simple straight forward substitutions ALSO ALLOW is the easier type to use


Example :-

Student X is authorized to substitute ENGL 2172 for ENGL 2030 and HIST 2172 for HIST 1120 for the purpose of fulfilling general education requirements.

APPLY HERE

If a department is approving the use of lower grade for a class that has a minimum grade requirement, then Apply Here is the only exception type that will work.

Eg. SOCI 3110 is approved to be used with a grade of D or higher.

Can be used when a course is waived or the student has pre banner hours.

Substituting two classes for one course

Most courses are scribed as 1 class in xyz so the first step is to change this limit

1. Select the **Remove Course/ Change the limit** option and add the number of credits the class is (3 or 4) or select 2 classes in the option box.
2. You can then use also allow to enter the two classes to be substituted
Now becomes 3 Credits in PSYC– This allows you to apply a 1 credit and 2 credit class on the same rule.
