Open Forum

- Heidi Davis: Little Bucs and Child Study Center, she is concerned about the deficit and how
 these programs may be cut. Call to Action about the TN budget crisis. There are child care
 programs on college campuses in the state of Tennessee that are similar.
- Secretary of External Affairs Johnny Krause is passing around concert t-shirt for SGA approval. There is a proposal to raise the fees for guests from \$10 to \$15 or \$20. Senator Price thinks that

- the guest fee should match the student fee to make it fair. Senator Clark says that the concerts he has seen at ETSU have been at least \$20 concerts.
- Sara Bradford is here to speak with us about the Winter Session this is a part of the spring term, because we are a part of TBR we cannot set up a standalone winter term. It will be a 5-week term and run 2 weeks into the spring term. The initial goal was to have 40-50 online courses of classes that were always full. There was a lot of interest when they contacted the faculty. The fee structure will be the same as the summer session. There will be a Student Supports Service during the week that ETSU is closed so that there are resources available for these classes.
 - Senator Price wanted to know if you took three hours over the winter session would those three hours go to your spring session, and the answer is yes.
 - Senator Neblett would like to see some of the fees go to the library since it would be an online class and there are computers in the library. The hope is that you can access the library and its resources electronically.
 - Senator Reed wants to know that if your hours roll over, will there still be the 21 hour limit? And the answer is yes, you'll still need the appropriate approvals to do that and that's just a check and balance to make sure that everyone is taken care of.
 - Senator Belanger wants to know if, as a hope scholar and 12 hours being a full time student, you take the 4 full time hours and then only 8 the spring semester would that qualify you? And the answer is that yes, that could happen but they hope that the winter session will not lower the spring session enrollment.
