- Karen from USA Today about Collegiate Readership Program
  - Designed to promote civic engagement through an assortment of newspapers
  - Nearly 500 Campus' participating
  - So you choose the newspapers that go on campus
  - Web-based resources
  - Distribution and choice
    - Can be an open container in a secure "student" building
    - And a student Id scanner building
  - Questions
    - Four week trial program
      - Come on campus, four weeks of free newspapers. Survey on the first day and then same survey on the last day
    - Distributed
      - The company does that, 50% off cover price
    - Locations
      - Ideally 4 or 5 different locations
    - Cost per year
      - \$4-5 per student per year
    - Working on putting newspapers online there are some kinks to work out
    - What happens with the extra papers
      - No charge for that, receive full credit for left over papers
    - Costs for id machines, newspaper holders
      - None, covered by the company
