

A RESOLUTION TO IMPLEMENT PLANS FOR IMPROVEMENT OF LIGHTING ON EAST TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY'S CAMPUS FROM SHERROD LIBRARY TO BUC RIDGE (SOUTHWEST AVENUE TO BUCCANEER RIDGE DRIVE), AS WELL AS FROM SHERROD LIBRARY THROUGH BORCHUCK PLAZA (MOST DIRECT PATH FROM SHERROD LIBRARY TO ROSS DRIVE) TO LUCILLE – CLEMENT AND LUNSFORD RESIDENTIAL HALLS.

Whereas, East Tennessee State University's campus serves as the home to many students who share a common concern for their personal safety, and;

Whereas, campus lighting on above stated paths does not provide adequate lighting conditions to supplement the safety of the campus population, and;

Whereas, Dan O'Brien, Environmental Director of East Tennessee State University has been informed of the paths in question and has showed an active interest in formulating a solution to these problems, and;

Whereas, Dan O'Brien stated that a lighting survey of the campus has not been performed in approximately two years and has introduced the issue to the Staff Senate of East Tennessee State University.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 2010-2011 STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION SENATE OF EAST TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1. The Student Government Association of East Tennessee State University respectfully requests the Staff Senate to work with the appropriate departments of the university to establish a regulated and enforceable schedule to regularly inspect, clean, and repair the lighting equipment already installed on the stated paths.

Section 2. The Student Government Association of East Tennessee State University respectfully requests Mr. Dan O'Brien to continue his efforts to work with the Johnson City Power Board and other appropriate departments and committees of the university to improve lighting conditions on the above stated paths through new and improved lighting equipment.
