

ETSU Administrative Hearing & campus Judicial Board Sanction Guide

Unless specified otherwise, these guidelines are based on the assumption that the case is a first-time offense. The decision to give all or some of the sanctions and the extent of any added sanctions are subject to the discretion of the hearing officer/ or board and will be based on the number of charges, the details and conditions surrounding the case (see Things That Could Affect Sanctions), and previous history and discipline.
