DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION ON LEAD-BASED PAINT AND LEAD-BASED PAINT HAZARDS

1. Lead Warning Statement

Housing built before 1978 may contain lead-based paint. Lead from paint, paint chips and dust can pose health hazards if not managed properly. Lead exposure is especially harmful to young children and pregnant women. Before renting pre-1978 housing, land lords must disclose the presence of known lead-based paint and lead-based paint hazards in the dwelling. Tenants must also receive a federally approved pamphlet on lead poisoning prevention.

2. Leaser's Disclosure:

A Review of paint purchases and use indicate that NO lead based paints have been bought or used by ETSU since 1980. A survey in 1996 of Buccaneer Village Apartments by Ecotech Environmental Inspectors of Knoxville, a licensed lead based testing paint company, resulted in negative findings for lead based paint.
