IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENT: All new incoming students, 22 years of age or younger that will be living on campus must show proof of vaccination for meningitis before being allowed to move into their assigned room/apartment. All documentation must be presented to the University Health Services before you will be allowed to move into your assigned room. WORK REQUESTS: All Housing facilities provide cable TV, Ethernet, and wireless access. Please find information regarding each at<u>www.etsu.edu/oit</u>. Work orders for Ethernet, WI-FI, or cable TV are to be reported directly to the shdesk@goldmail.etsu.edu or call 423-439-4648. Personal routers may cause interference and slow access. **All other maintenance requests are to be** reported immediately and directly to Housing Facilities at HOUSINGWORK@LISTSERV.ETSU.EDU.

TUITION, FEES, RENT/MEAL PLAN PAYMENTS are due by Friday, August 22 at 6pm or else your classes will be purged, and you will be unable to access your residence hall, room, meal plan, CPA, and etc.

CHECK IN/ID CARD: All residents must be checked into their room/apartment by 6pm on Sunday, August 24 to secure assigned room. After this date and time, re-assignments may be made to maximize space. Please make prior arrangements for later check-in, if necessary. Failure to move into assigned room does not cancel your housing contract or your obligation to pay rent. Present your SID card upon checking in to your assigned residence hall. Access to the halls is via your ID card which is activated upon registering for classes and payment of fees. Residents of Davis, Powell, Governors, Carter, Luntsford, Centennial, and parts of Buc Ridge access their individual rooms via their ID cards which must be encoded by Staff at check-in. Per University policy, your are to keep your ID card with you at all times and never loan it to anyone.

RESIDENT ADVANTAGE MEAL PLANS begin Monday, August 25 for breakfast in the Marketplace. If you have not already purchased a plan, please do so today at the Housing Office or www.etsudining.com.
