

College Terminology

Academic Advisor: An academic mentor who guides the student through your degree.

Advisors assist with course registration, make sure the student is taking the right courses in the right order, and help them make important academic decisions. Every first-year student is assigned an advisor. When a student declares a major, they receive a new advisor in that department.

3 College Tips

1. Get to know your roommate and others in your residence hall.

Contact your roommate(s) before moving in. Start building that relationship. Others in your dorm are probably freshman as well and are having similar feelings, emotions, and experiences.

- 2. **Get Organized.** In high school, teachers tend to guide students more and remind them of due dates and assignments. In college, professors may post due dates for the entire semester, and it is your responsibility to know and complete assignments. Suggestions are a planner, app on your phone, big wall calendar, reminders on your phone, etc. Whatever works for you.
