WHAT THEY DO

Patient care, maintain medical records, educate patients and the public about various health conditions, and provide advice and emotional support.

Medical assistants perform administrative and clinical duties under the direction of a physician. Duties may include scheduling to taking and recording vital signs.

Registered nurses are the largest healthcare occupation with over 20,000 openings expected in Minnesota over the next 10 years.

Statewide demand is high with 3,330 openings expected in the next 10 years.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

RN's work in hospitals, physicians' offices, home healthcare services, and nursing care facilities. They are in close contact with people and may spend a lot of time on their feet.

Medical assistants work in physicians' offices, hospitals, outpatient clinics, and other healthcare facilities. They are in constant interaction with people and must have the ability to multi-task.
