Did you know that during your junior and senior year, you have the opportunity to take the ACT up to 6 times for free? Through Upward Bound, you can receive two fee waivers during both your junior and senior year. You will also take the ACT for free with your school during the spring of your junior year and the fall of your senior year. COLLEGE TERMINOLOGY

<u>Credit Hours</u>: A unit of measurement that indicates how much credit a student receives for taking a course.

<u>Part Time Student</u>: Student who takes fewer classes than a full-time student. Typically, students who take 11 or few credit hours per semester.

<u>Full-Time Student</u>: Student who is enrolled in the number of credit hours that their school requires for full-time attendance. Generally, this is 12+ credit hours per semester.

Quick Fact: Financial aid can be affected depending on if a student is part- or full-time. Some grants, scholarships, etc. require a student to be full-time including TN Promise.

- Register for TN Promise! Application is open now.
- Narrow down which colleges you plan to apply to.
- Look into different community service opportunities for the 8 required hrs. for TN Promise. Only hours completed between Nov. 1, 2025 – July 1, 2025 count towards your TN Promise requirement. UB will be announcing some service projects soon!
- Register for the ACT if you plan to re-take! Ask your school visit rep for a fee waiver if you need one.
