SUMMER FAQ'S

What is the Upward Bound summer program?

Every summer, UB students get to live on the ETSU campus and expereince an example of college life. Students live in dorms, take classes, eat meals in the cafeteria and participate in a wide variety of recreation and cultural activities.

→ Who participates in the UB summer program?

Any freshmen, sophomores, or juniors who are currently in Upward Bound can participate in summer.

→ What are UB summer classes?

Students take a variety of classes that are both acacemic and activity based. These classes are not for credit, but are meant to help enrich students' high school curriculum.

When is the 2022 summer program?

Students will move in on May 31st and move out on July 1st. During these dates, students go homoe on Friday afternoons and come back to campus on Stundy evenings

What is the summer trip?

UB students who successfully participate in the summer program are invited to attend a trip after the summer program. Students find out where we are going later in the spring.



When is the summer trip?

We are still finalizing dates, but the trip will most likely be the week of July 11th. The trip usually runs 3-5 days.

+ How much does the summer program cost?

The summer program and the trip are completely free to students. UB covers all meals, tickets, hotels, and provides any necessary spending money on the trip.

+ How do I sign up for the summer program?

You do not need to do anything special to sign up. Staff will help you select your classes at an April session.

What can I bring to the dorm?

We know students and guardians have lot so questions about summer! We will answer this and other questions at a session in April. We will also have a partent meeting before summer to cover details.

→ What is the Upward Bound Bridge program?

The Bridge program is a special program for UB seniors that takes place the summer after they graduate from high school. Students are able to live on campus and receive support while taking college classes. This program is only for UB seniors.
