During a meeting of the Interim University Council (IUC) earlier this semester, discussions took place on identifying a process by which members of the ETSU community could provide feedback on proposed new policies for the university. From those conversations, I am pleased to announce the creation of a new website designed to allow students, faculty and staff the opportunity to review some proposed policies and offer suggestions or ask questions. Those draft policies placed on the site will be available for public comment for a determined period of time, such as 30 days or 60 days.
