- February 1974 signed on the air
- 1980 Became first satellite-connected radio station in the Tri-Cities
- 1987 Became 24hour service

- 1994 Opened translator station in Lenoir, N.C.
- 2000 Began audio streaming on the Internet
- 2011 Became first HD radio service in Tri-Cities; we now have 4 HD channels

WETS-FM (89.5)


- Beloved gem of the community.

 Our broadcast coverage area is approximately a 100mile radius from Johnson City.
















State Revenue

Personnel Considerations

- In 2004, WETS had 9 full-time employees and 3 part-time employees.
- Presently, WETS has 6 full-time employees and 3 part-time employees.
- The Corporation for Public Broadcasting requires a station to have 5 full-time employees to qualify for a Community Service Grant.
- Personnel Costs 2014-15: \$393,847 (salaries);
 \$154,346 (benefits) 9 full-time, 3 part-time
