

# Dress Code for School Sponsored Dances:

Be aware that the dress code applies to all attendees, including guests of our students even if they are not students at University School. The dress code will be enforced. If your attire does not meet the dress code, you will not be allowed to attend unless you modify your attire to meet the dress code.

## Dress code for Special Occasions (dances, etc)

- No curvature of the breasts can be visible. Your top must come high enough to cover your chest.
- Length of dresses can be no higher than 5 inches above the knee. This applies to slits as well.
- The back of the dress can be no lower than midway down the back of the wearer.
- The waist area must be covered by apparel at all times. Exposed midriff is not acceptable.
- Spaghetti straps or strapless dresses are acceptable.
- Sheer sections on a dress are acceptable ONLY IF the opaque sections meet the requirements.

### Examples of acceptable and unacceptable attires:

#### Acceptable:



Cleavage is fully covered.



This dress itself is long enough. The sheer section does not show above 5" above the knee.



The slit on this dress is no higher than 5" from the knee.

#### Unacceptable:



The cutout shows midriff. The length is too short.



These dresses have a transparent/sheer midsection showing midriff. The slits are too high.



The bottom part of the dress is sheer/transparent. The dress itself, the part that is non-transparent, is too short.



Cleavage is visible and the dress is too short.



The back of this dress is too low.
