Certain items such as pencils, lead, pens, and erasers will need to be replenished for your child throughout the year.

Please <u>CLEARLY</u> label headphones, scissors, notebooks, folders, and water bottle with student name.

The following items all students <u>must</u> have:

Personal Supplies Please unpack pens, pencils, scissors, colored pencils, erasers & put in pencil pouch.	Classroom supplies Please send all supplies on the first day of school.
4 Composition Notebooks (non-spiral & needs to have 100 sheets of paper or more) Clearly label with student name and subject: Math, Science, Social Studies, Reading 2 plastic folders with brads (preferred colors blue and yellow) 2 packs of pencils (mechanical or wooden) 1 small pencil pouch to store in seat sack (pencil boxes or large pouches will not fit) 1 pair of kid size scissors 1 box of 24 count colored pencils 1 pack of large erasers (i.e. Pink Pearl) 1 pack colored ink pens (any non-neon color) 1 pair of durable headphones 1 plastic (translucent) water bottle	4 boxes of facial tissues (3 for the classroom/1 for specials) 1 container of Clorox Wipes 1 Roll of Paper Towels 2 packs of skinny highlighters (multi-colored pack) 1 pack of Expo Brand Markers (fine point tip) 2 packs of Post-It 2" durable filing tabs 8 glue sticks
