In general, for one college class students will earn 3 semester hours of college credit and 1 high school credit for the same class. College courses can be taken to meet graduation requirements with the appropriate approval. You will be able to take freshman and sophomore level courses like English Composition, Probability and Statistics, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, US History, Psychology, Astronomy, Sociology, Using Information Technology, Fine Arts and many, many others.
